
Conflict: Terminology

- Conflict: From L. conflictus, pp. of confligere "to strike together," from con- "together" + fligere "to strike"
- The Arabic equivalent of <mark>conflict</mark> is not **niza' (نزاع)** or **tanaazu'** (نزاع) but:
- Tadharub from from "ta" (together) + "dharub" (to strike) ت ب فارب = تضارب


Conflict: Definition in conflictology

Daynamic relation between two or more parties (indivuduals, groups, states, civilizations) with (apparently) contradictory goals (positions, interests, needs, values).
